- 5. **Greenbelt Review** a meeting was attended by Cllr. Sugden and surrounding parishes with Mike Dunphy Strategic Planning Manager, Bromsgrove District Council to discuss maybe having a combined Bromsgrove Parish Council Neighbourhood Plan. He also confirmed that the Bromsgrove District Plan would completed early 2017 at which time a Greenbelt Review would commence starting in spring 2017.
